Introduction and purpose

Through the support of the ERASMUS+ Programme and the European Universities initiative, in coherence with the Alliance educational strategy, the EU GREEN Alliance launches its first open call for STA mobility (Staff Mobility for Teaching Assignment).

The Call is aimed at promoting interaction among disciplines and teaching staff within the EU GREEN Alliance by using the ERASMUS+ Programme as a solid tool for the network development.

Staff mobility can be carried out by any type of higher education staff. To ensure high-quality mobility activities with maximum impact, the mobility activity must be related to the staff's professional profile and to address their learning and personal development needs.

Mobility for teaching periods can also be aimed at the creation of new methodologies and/or new academic pathways in both the home and the destination institution involved in the exchange.

In the framework of the EU GREEN Alliance, each partner is sharing the disciplinary areas or the topics of teaching where the contribution of teaching staff from one of the other EU GREEN partner universities is required.

This Call collects the available positions for the forthcoming Spring Semester 2024/2025 and, exceptionally, for other periods of the forthcoming academic year 2025/2026.

Conditions of participation

1. **The ERASMUS+ for STA/STT mobility rules apply to the mobilities available in this Call.** Please refer to your local International Office for any detail needed.
2. All the mobilities available in this Call must take place in the period between 20th February 2025 and 31st July 2026;
3. In order to allow the scrolling of the ranking list for the same position, in case of withdrawal after selection, the awarding candidate is asked to notify the withdrawal at least 30 (thirty) days before the beginning of the teaching activity at the host University. The obligation does not apply to cases of “force majeure” as identified by the ERASMUS+ Programme.

Duration and workload

As fixed by the ERASMUS+ Programme, the duration of STA mobility may vary from a minimum of 2 to a maximum of 60 days, excluding travel days. The real duration of each single mobility available in this Call will be agreed between the receiving and the hosting institution, in accordance with the local regulations set the home university of the involved teaching staff unit.

Activity for teaching purposes must include at least 8 hours of teaching per week (or per period of stay, whichever is shorter). If the mobility lasts more than one week, the minimum number of teaching hours for the incomplete week must be proportional to the duration of that week, as illustrated in the table below:

Applying to the Call

Each teaching staff unit interested in one or more of the available positions must complete the application form available [HERE](#) (you may also use the QR Code provide below) by no later than **09th 13th FEBRUARY 2025**. In order of

preference, each applicant may identify a maximum of 2 (two) available teaching slots.



Selection criteria and mobility flows payable by each EU GREEN University as sending institution

Immediately after the deadline, a Selection Committee will evaluate the candidacies to select the candidate for each available position. The Committee is formed by WP2, WP3 and WP6 representatives.

The selection criteria adopted by the Committee (up to a maximum of 50 points) are the following:

- Applicant's scientific profile and coherence with the topics requested by the destination University:
 - o from 10 to 30 points
- Applicant's seniority
 - o 0-5 yrs 10 points
 - o 6-10 yrs 8 points
 - o 11-15 yrs 6 points
 - o More than 15 yrs 4 points
- Previous experiences in teaching abroad
 - o 0 experiences: 0 points
 - o 1 point for each short (up to 30 days) teaching period (up to a maximum of 4 experiences)
 - o 2 points for each long (longer than 30 days) teaching period (up to a maximum of 3 experiences)

In case of even result of two or more candidates for the same position, priority will be given to the following:

- o The younger applicant (age) prevails

Of course, the number of available positions as hosting institution is higher than the number of fundable positions made available by each EU GREEN University as sending institution.
